<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> That the Watershed Conservation Authority Governing Board receive and file the Fund Balance Report.

BACKGROUND: Attached as Exhibit A is the FY 2017/18 Fund Balance Report with balances as of August 31, 2017.

Key changes in the Fund Balance Report are summarized below:

- V15/JPAWCA & V52/Personnel: Increase in fund balances primarily due to a transfer of operational funds to cover salary, benefit, and administrative expenditures.
- V20/El Encanto Operational: Increase in fund balance primarily due to receipt of citation revenues collected during Fiscal Year 2016/17.
- V38/Duck Farm Phase 1A: Decrease in fund balance due to Project Management labor activity and weed abatement services.
- V52/Duck Farm/Mt. Baldy Outreach Support: Decrease in fund balance due to Project Management labor activity and associated expenditures for public outreach activities.
- V61/Cattle Canyon Improvement: Increase in fund balance due to reimbursement from USFS for Project Management labor and associated expenditures for the Cattle Canyon project.
- V66/EcoVoices: Increase in fund balance due to reimbursement from USFS for Project Management labor.
- Other minimal fluctuations in various fund balances are directly related to labor and/or quarterly accrued interest posted for July and August 2017.
