

Legal Notice for Draft EIS/EIR Comment Period
San Gabriel River Confluence with Cattle Canyon Improvements Project

The Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report (Draft EIS/EIR) for the San Gabriel River Confluence with Cattle Canyon Improvements Project is now available for public review and comment. The project is intended to better manage the recreation use and balance of the needs for resource protection. This project area encompasses 198 acres and is located on the San Gabriel Mountains National Monument, Angeles National Forest (T2N R8W Sections 19 and 30; T2N R9W Sections 24, 25, 26; and T3N R8W Section 18).

The Draft EIS/EIR analyzes the environmental consequences of the no action alternative and the proposed action. Documents are available on the Angeles National Forest's project webpage at: <https://www.fs.usda.gov/projects/angeles/landmanagement/projects> and the Watershed Conservation Authority's project page at: http://www.wca.ca.gov/cattle_canyon. Public meetings will be held on November 18, 2017 and December 5, 2017.

This project is subject to 36 CFR 218 for objection/administrative review. Only those who submit timely project-specific written comments during a public comment period are eligible to file an objection. Individuals or representatives of an entity submitting comments must sign the comments or verify identity upon request. Comments received, including the names and addresses of those who comment, will be considered part of the public record on this proposal and will be available for public inspection.

The Forest Service will accept comments on this proposal for 45 days following publication of this legal notice, which is the exclusive means for calculating the comment period. Commenters should not rely upon dates or timeframe information provided by any other source. It is the commenter's responsibility to ensure timely receipt of comments (36 CFR 218.25).
