DESCRIPTION: The Golden Manhole Award is to recognize an individual(s) who has shown dedication to the area of sewer (wastewater and stormwater) collection systems.

REQUIREMENTS: The Golden Manhole Award significant participation in one or more of the following areas: Operations, Maintenance, Design, Education, Training, Certification, Management and Planning of Sewer Collection Systems.

EVALUATION CRITERIA: Induction will be decided by a minimum of three members of the Selection Committee. The committee will use the following criteria to select a nominee for the award. The nominee must meet at least three of the criteria below in order to be eligible. The individual recipient must be a current member in good standing of WEAO.

1. Ten years of experience and significant participation in the one or more of the areas listed in the above section titled REQUIREMENTS;
2. Leadership in the development and/or implementation of innovative solutions to collection system problems;
3. Involvement in promoting the professional recognition of the collection system field;
4. Participation in the Water Environment Association of Ontario's Collections System Committee; (minimum 3 years active member of collection systems committee);
5. Papers or articles accepted by provincial, regional or national publications. Technical presentations at professional conferences;
6. Membership in WEF National Collection Systems Committee.
