

PROJECT: 6394 - Minnesota Avenue Sanitary Sewer Improvement

General Description: This project will remove and replace approximately 2,200 feet of 12-inch sewer main on Minnesota Avenue between Bird Avenue and Lincoln Avenue. The project was developed to address a problematic sewer main that runs along Minnesota Avenue which has experienced blockages and overflows in recent years largely due to a very flat slope of the pipe line.

Street to be impacted: Minnesota Ave between Lincoln Ave and Bird Ave

Work at the intersections of Minnesota Ave and Lincoln Ave and at Minnesota Ave and Bird Ave will be done during off-peak hours. Police Officers will be used at the signalized intersections to help direct traffic as needed. Access to driveways will be made available. For businesses with multiple driveways, at least one will be made available. Short delays to driveway access may be experienced during times when active construction is occurring directly in front of the driveway. Staff will work with property owners to minimize the impact of the construction activities.

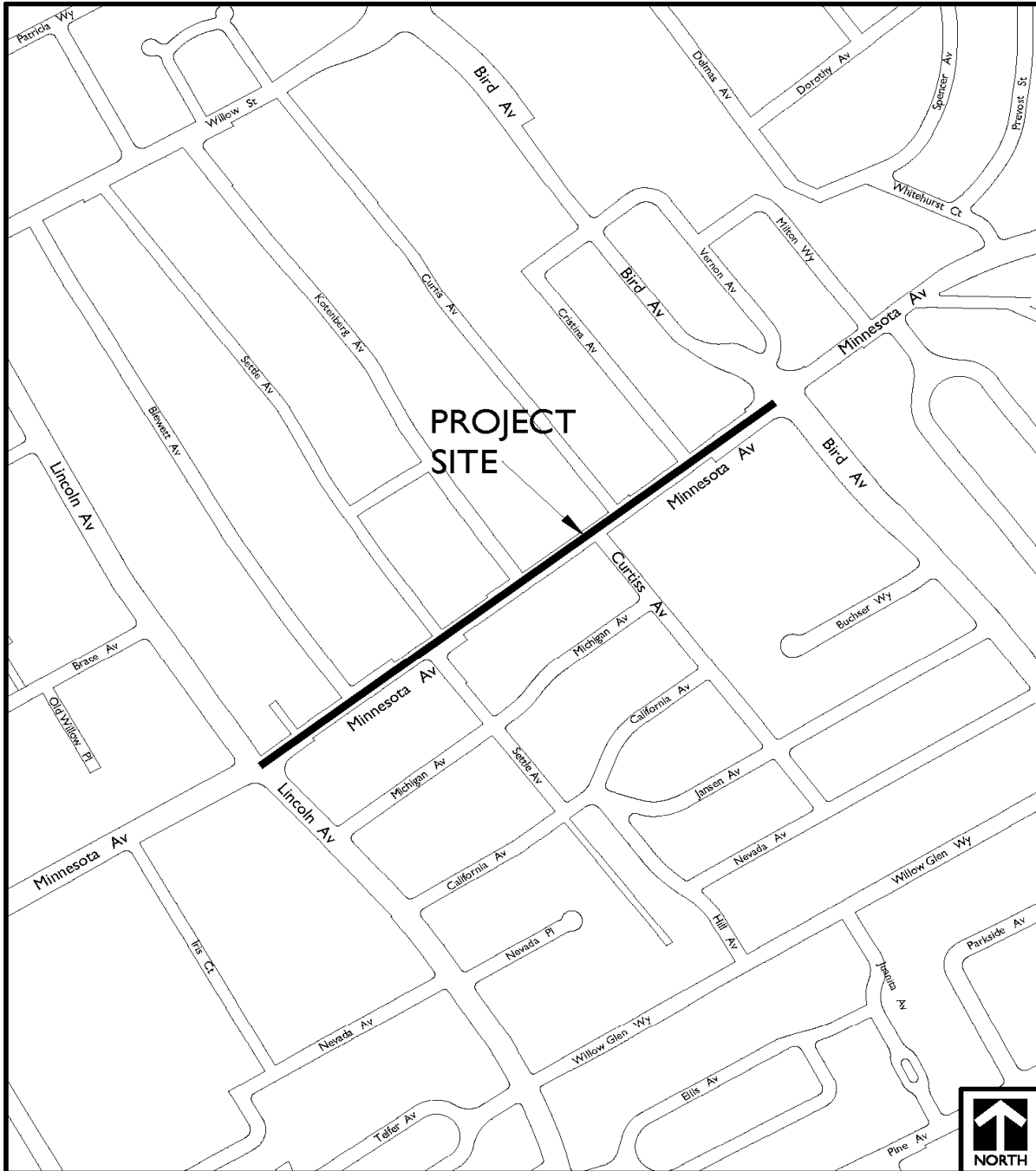
