

## Council District 6

**PROJECT:** Mackey Ave, Dawson Ave & Cross Way Sanitary Sewer Replacement

**General Description:** This project will remove and replace approximately 2,300 linear feet of 6-inch sanitary sewer main on Mackey Avenue, Dawson Avenue and Cross Way. The existing sewer system was built during the 1950s, which currently requires frequent maintenance by City crews. A portion of the existing system have been re-engineered to improve sewer flows. This project also includes reconstruction of eight existing manholes and reconnection of laterals for seventy-seven lots. This project is funded out of Sanitary Sewer Funds which can be used towards sanitary sewer improvements only.

**Streets to be Impacted:**

Traffic on Mackey Avenue, Cross Way, and Dawson Avenue is anticipated to be impacted during construction (see map on reverse). Work will be done during off-peak hours between 8:30am and 4:30pm. Construction activities will be phased to minimize impacts to residents. Driveway access will be maintained, except for short duration when active construction is occurring directly in front of the driveway. Staff will work with the contractor and the property owners to minimize impacts during construction.

**Project Cost:** Approximately \$1,644,000

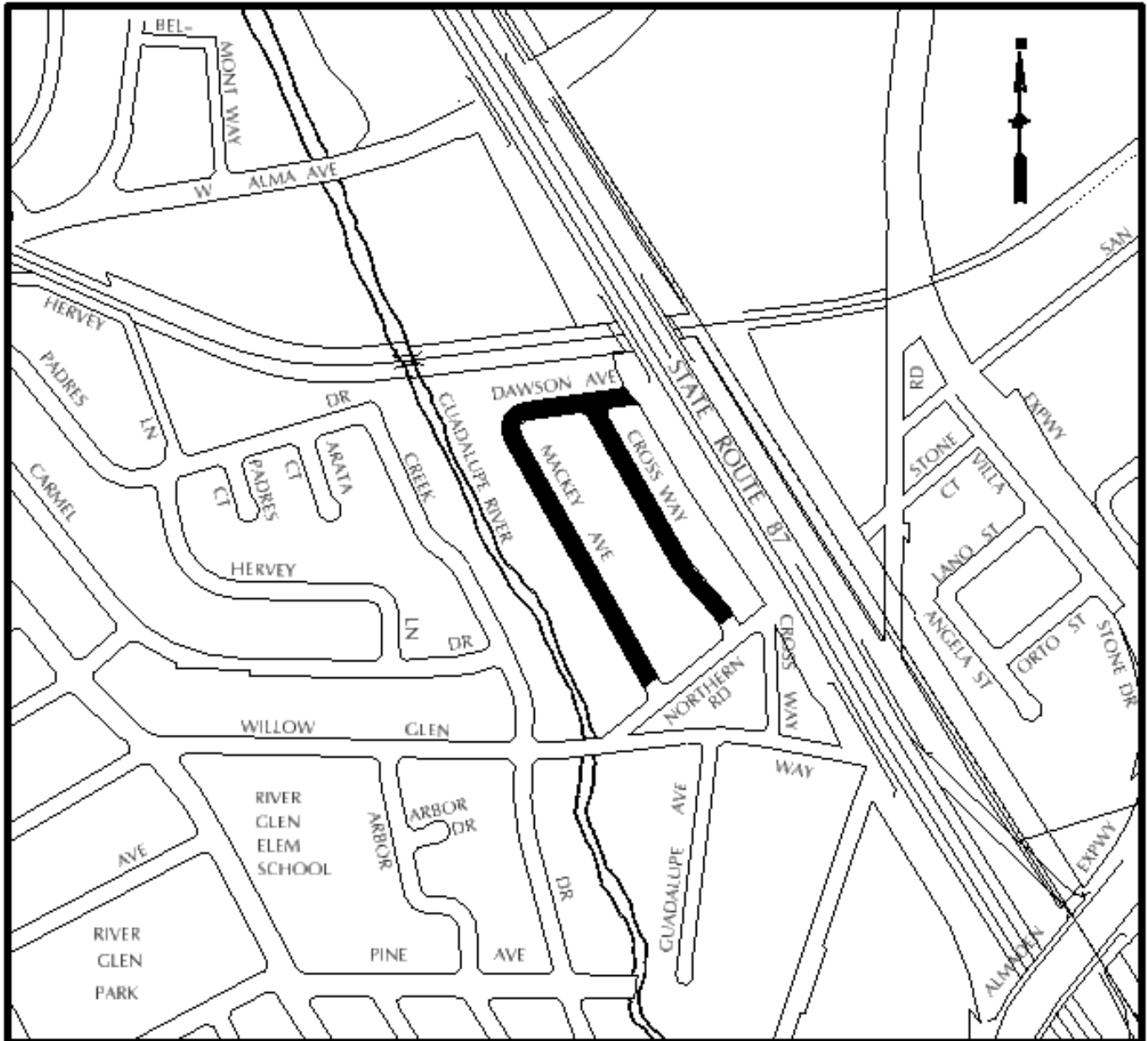
**Schedule:** Estimated Start of Construction: November 2014
