## Stories of the Women You Have Helped

### \*Maya

Maya was a 17-year-old high school student who found herself pregnant. As someone who had been raised by a single mother on welfare, she dreamed of something more for her future. When she learned of her pregnancy, she made the difficult decision to have an abortion because she wanted to make something of herself before starting a family. Your help enabled Maya to have the opportunity to delay starting a family, in order to finish school and be in a much better position to raise the family she had dreamed of.

### Tanisha

Tanisha was a struggling single mother with a 6-month-old son. When she went for a regular check up, she had no idea she was pregnant. The thought of having two children within a year, with only her to provide for them was unimaginable. The help of Women Have Options enabled Tanisha to make the decision that was best for her and her family.

### Aisha

Aisha had a serious medical condition that required medical clearance from her regular doctor. Getting clearance was difficult because her doctor held anti-choice beliefs, expressed them to her, and delayed her abortion. By the time she was cleared, she was 13 weeks along in the pregnancy. With Ohio's 24-hour waiting period, Aisha had to make two visits to her clinic, totaling 240 miles of driving, since there was no abortion provider in her area. Your contributions assisted Aisha in making a very expensive and time consuming choice.

### Jenny

Abby had been in an abusive relationship for two years. Shortly after she made the courageous decision to leave this relationship with her two children, she found out she was pregnant. She was unable to afford an abortion on her own, and was terrified at the thought of returning to the abusive relationship. Thank you for helping Jenny afford the choice she needed for her life and family.
