**Title:** Appointments to the Steering Committee and the Appeals Body

**Proposed by:** The Women's Equality Party's Steering Committee

**Proposer:** Steering Committee

**Type of motion:** Business motion

**Motion Text:**

- 1 1. With reference to Article 7.5.12(vi) of the Constitution regarding appointments to the Steering  
2 Committee, WE Party Conference 2020 accepts the following appointments to the Steering  
3 Committee:
  - 4 a) Sellisha Lockyer, who will take a seat on the Steering Committee for a term of three  
5 years or until the next Party Conference following;
  - 6 b) Daniella Jenkins, who will take a seat on the Steering Committee for a term of three  
7 years or until the next Party Conference following;
  - 8 c) Kay Wesley, who will take a seat on the Steering Committee for a term of three years or  
9 until the next Party Conference following.
- 10 2. With reference to Article 7.5.12(iii), Eileen Scholes will take a seat on the Steering Committee  
11 as London Hub representative until her term as London Hub Co-ordinator is up, to be  
12 renewed if that term is renewed.
- 13 3. With reference to Articles 10.1.2 and 10.1.4 of the Constitution regarding the terms of office  
14 and the appointment of the Appeals Body, WE Party Conference 2020 ratifies the following  
15 reappointments by the Steering Committee to the Appeals Body:
  - 16 a) Shelagh McCall, who will be reappointed to the Appeals Body for a further term of four  
17 years.
  - 18 b) Karis McClarty, who will be reappointed to the Appeals Body for a further term of four  
19 years.



**Motion rationale:**

20 The Steering Committee is responsible for appointing five members to the Steering Committee,  
21 under Article 7.5.12.(vi) of the Constitution. Three of these appointments have now been made –  
22 another two are to come. We commend Sellisha Lockyer, Daniella Jenkins and Kay Wesley to  
23 Conference.

24 Eileen Scholes is the first Hub rep to take her place on the Steering Committee under Article  
25 7.5.12(iii) of the Constitution. We commend her to Conference.

26 The Steering Committee is also responsible for appointing and reappointing the five members of  
27 the Appeals Body. Shelagh McCall's and Karis McLarty's terms in office end at Conference and  
28 they have agreed to serve for a second term. We commend Shelagh McCall and Karis McLarty  
29 to Conference.
