San Diego Measure D	YES - SDUSD school board members should be able to be removed for cause by $\frac{3}{4}$ vote of the school board.				
San Diego Measure E	YES - Allows for buildings higher than 30 feet to be built in the area of Interstate 8 on the north, the San Diego International Airport on the south, Interstate 5 on the east, and Lytton Drive on the west that allows for the building of low-income housing.
