Dangerous, unhealthy & unsafe conditions exist within the schools in Philadelphia. These conditions pose real health risks to our children & to adult staff responsible for educating and protecting our children. Serious hazards include asbestos, mold, lead, persistent moisture & dampness, problems with ventilation, rodent & insect infestations, rooms too hot or too cold to use, & leaks from roofs, walls & air conditioning systems and these problems are largely preventable using cost effective and practical solutions.

We know that the Philadelphia School District (PSD) needs more money so:

- WHY WOULD THEY REFUSE ENTRY TO THE US CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL [CDC] (NATL INSTITUTE FOR
  OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH, NIOSH) to conduct a government funded health hazard evaluation
  [HHE] to better evaluate the hazards & to develop a cost effective plan to fix these problems?;
- WHY WOULD THE PSD ALSO STOP A MAJOR FUNDED HEALTH STUDY OF 50 ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS TO
  EVALUATE INDOOR AIR QUALITY ISSUES conditions affecting not only the health of our children but also their
  ability to learn?;
- Why has the PSD Management refused to work in cooperation and collaboration with the unions, the teachers, the maintenance workers, the parents & others in a transparent, open and honest manner; &
- Why has the PSD refused to provide the public, school stakeholders, occupants, unions and the press with requested documents & information about the conditions in our schools & about what will be done to fix them & when

WE DEMAND that the Philadelphia School District's position on the health studies/evaluations IMMEDIATELY BE REVERSED & that the CDC/NIOSH Indoor Air Quality study of our elementary schools and the Health Hazard Evaluation [HHE] begins at once! We also demand that the PSD immediately collaborate & cooperate with unions and other stakeholders, to evaluate and address Health and Safety problems and that information, reports & documents be shared openly and completely.
