

STREET-ART-ACTION

OPEN SHUHDA STREET




Make street-art to bring attention to the massacre and the Open-Shuuda-Street campaign in your city.

1. Make or buy 29 human-size figures. The figures can for example be lab coats, figures cut form sheets, balloon inside of a big garbage bag (with a rope tied underneath the balloon). Symbolizing the killed in the Ibrahimi massacre 1994.
2. Decide location. Find a place where a lot of people pass by. Best place is if it could be on the main shopping street to resemble the consequence if the main street of a town where to be closed.

Permission may be needed for putting up the art work. The longer the art-work can be up, the better for generating awareness of the massacre and for bring publicity to the campaign.

3. Hang up a total of 29 human size figures over the street, preferably in roads (4x6 + 5) for best impact.
4. Put up a sign/ signs (think about making it water-proof). Make a schedule for people to stand and talk with bypassing people. Give out flyers about the campaign.



Goal:

- Bring attention to the Ibrahimi massacre
- Bring attention to the Open Shuhada street campaign
- Give bypassing people options to take stand or engage in the campaign (invite to public lectures, sign a petition, sign up on YAS newsletter list, sign up to help with the campaign next year, etc)

Time:

Put up the art work in connection to the campaign in your town. If you are having a public event/ events make sure the art-work can work as advertisement for the campaign by outting it up a couple days before the date of the event.

Sign:

Write a text that awakes further interest, explains a bit of the unjust situation and calls for action from the by-passers. On the sign add a QR-code for people to get more information about the campaign.

If the art-work hangs on the main-street or a shopping street you can write the heading like if the massacre happened at that street and was committed by a neighbouring town/ country. For example, if it is put up on Oxford street in London:

29 people was murdered here in 1994 by a fanatic-religious man from Manchester. After the massacre, the army of Manchester forcefully closed 513 shops and closed this street for the citizens of London. Today 24 years later the citizens of London are still not allowed to drive or even walk on Oxford Street. Internationals and people from Manchester walk freely on the whole street.

The massacre didn't occur here but just a couple of hours away with an airplane in a city called Al-Kahlil (Hebron) on the West Bank in Palestine...

Example for a text on the sign:

Apartheid in the Palestinian city of Al-Khalil

29 PEOPLE MURDED

A people was murdered and then punished for it, when will the international community react?

On February 25, 1994, an Israeli settler named Baruch Goldstein entered the Ibrahimi Mosque during Raman's Friday prayer and killed 29 Palestinians and injured more than 100. The consequences of the massacre affected the Palestinians not the illegally Israeli settlers. Immediately after the massacre, a curfew was put on the Palestinians in the city and over 500 shops on Shuada Street, the main street, were closed by the Israeli army. Even today, in 2018, the Palestinians aren't allowed to drive or even walk on the main street in their own city. As an international or Israeli settlers, you can walk at the whole street without restrictions. This is the APARTHEID 2018.

It's time for justice. For 24 years, the Palestinians have been denied the right to walk on their own street. Refused to reopen their business on the street and refused to get into their homes through their front door.

We want to see that Shuada Street is opened to ALL people, what do you want to see? Sign the petition.

Apartheid i den palestinska staden Al-Khalil 29 MÄNNISKOR DÖDADES

Ett folk mördas och straffades sedan för det, när ska omvärlden börja reagera?

Den 25 Februari 1994 gick en Israelisk bosättare vid namn Baruch Goldstein in i Ibrahimi moskén under ramdagsfredagsbön och sköt ihjäl 29 palestinier och skadade mer än 100. Konsekvenserna efter **massaken** drabbade palestinerna i staden inte de Israeliska bosättarna. Direkt efter massaken sattes ett utgångsförbud på palestinerna i staden och över 500 affärer på huvudgatan **Shuada Street** stängdes av den Israeliska armén. Än idag, år 2018, får Palestinierna fortfarande inte gå på huvudgatan i sin egna stad. Som internationell eller Israelisk bosättare kan du gå på hela gatan. Det här är **APARTHEID**.

Det är dags för rättvisa. I 24 år har Palestinierna nekats rätten att gå på sin egen gatan. Nekats att öppna sina affärer igen. Nekats att få gå in till deras hem genom sin framdörr.
