2. have applied to enter a program or must be returning to a post-secondary institution on a full-time basis in September, 2015.
3. not be a past recipient of the WRLC Scholarship.

### **CRITERIA:**

The applicant must submit the complete application form along with:

1. a brief resume outlining non-academic interests and activities, such as community or political involvement.
2. provide evidence of understanding of the role and significance of the labour movement by completing essay on provided topic of not more than 500 words.
3. a complete secondary school transcript or transcript of post-secondary study.
