

**PSAC NATIONAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS – COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND THE  
SUSPENSION OF TIMELINES - 3**  
**April 2020**

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**WHEREAS** public health directives in response to the COVID-19 pandemic have banned public gatherings, closed many workplaces, and enforced the self-isolation of our membership;

**WHEREAS** the pandemic and these directives have forced many Components to reschedule their Conventions which had been scheduled to occur between July and October 2020, into 2021;

**WHEREAS** such Convention rescheduling could conflict with the timeline requirements contained in Section 8, Sub-Section (9) and Section 9, Sub-Sections (4)(b) and (13) of the PSAC Constitution;

**WHEREAS** the National Board of Directors has approved the suspension of timelines contained in Local, Branch, DCL, Regional, Area Council, and Component By-Laws regarding the scheduling of Annual General Meetings, Conventions, and the election of delegates to Component and PSAC Conventions;

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the timelines related to Component Conventions as contained in Section 8, Sub-Section (9) and Section 9, Sub-Sections (4)(b) and (13) of the PSAC Constitution be suspended;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the timelines related to Directly Chartered Locals general membership meetings as contained in Section 11, Sub-Section (4) (a) and (b) of the PSAC Constitution be suspended;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the timelines related to Area Councils general membership meetings and resolutions submission as contained in Section 14, Sub-Sections (13)(b) and (14)(b) of the PSAC Constitution be suspended.
