FOR THE ATTENTION OF LOCAL EXECUTIVES

Please be informed: The 9th Triennial Convention of the Yukon Employees' Union (YEU) will be held from October 27-29, 2021. The convention will be held *virtually* in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, which will allow you attend straight from your home. Tablets will be provided to all registered delegates and alternates for ease of access. To accommodate for the expected high internet expenditure, a \$50 credit will be provided to all attendees.

More details on the virtual convention will be provided in the coming months. The convention will open at 9:00 am on Wednesday, October 27th and conclude at 5:00 pm on Friday, October 29th.

Representation at the 9th Triennial Convention:

- i. Each YEU Local shall elect accredited delegates to the convention of YEU from amongst its members at a general meeting of the Local.
- ii. Each YEU Local is entitled to two delegates for up to 100 members, or any portion thereof, and one additional delegate for each additional 50 members, or major portion thereof. Based on current membership information, we *estimate* your Local's delegate entitlement to be XX. Final entitlements will be confirmed based on membership numbers as of July 5th.
- iii. Each YEU Local shall elect alternate delegates who shall attend the Triennial Convention in place of any accredited delegates who unavoidably cannot attend Convention. The Locals shall choose which alternate delegate is to replace a delegate unable to attend the Convention.
- iv. Immediately following election of Local delegates to the Triennial Convention, the Local Secretary shall submit to the Component President the names of the Local's accredited delegates on a credential form supplied by the headquarters office of the component (attached).

Deadline for registration of Delegates and Alternates is June 30th

All costs related to the general meetings of the Locals are the responsibility of the Local. Exceptions may be approved by application to the Component President.
