Yukon Employees Union is offering 8 Bursaries to our members and their dependents for the 2020/2021 school year.

- Bursaries are \$1000 each
- At least one of the Bursaries is designated for a student pursuing Trades
- The Percy Andrews & JoAnn Smith Memorial Bursary will be awarded for the first time this year, honouring these two leading activists from the Yukon's labour community, both of whom passed away in 2020.

Bursaries are for Yukon Employee members in good standing and their dependents.

Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary university or college, attending either on campus or remotely due to Covid-19 changes implemented by the school.

Applicant Requirements whether application is submitted by mail or online:

- Completed Bursary Application form with all fields completed
- Proof of enrollment issued by the post-secondary education institution **must** be included with the Application.

IMPORTANT: All applicants **must submit*** a 500-word essay that answers **one** of the following questions:

What do you see as the role of unions now and in the future?

OR

What do you see as the role of Yukon Employees' Union now and in the future?

**This essay should be uploaded and attached as a pdf, doc or docx file to the digital application or included with your hard-copy application.*
