



Liaison to YNPn National Position Description

Board Objectives:

The Board of Directors has the responsibility of carrying out the mission and vision of YNPn-Madison. The Board implements and supports plans, policies and objectives to ensure it maintains its values and meets established goals. The Board is a governing body with legal and ethical obligations to the organization and its membership.

Position Objective:

YNPN National holds monthly conference calls with a group called the Chapter Congress, which consists of staff from YNPn National and a liaison from every YNPn chapter. Each Chapter Congress session covers a topic relevant to YNPn National and YNPn chapters, and allows for information sharing and feedback from National-to-chapter, chapter-to-chapter, and chapter-to-National.

Key Roles and Responsibilities:

- Solicit feedback from fellow board members before a call to ensure our opinions are voiced
- Participate in the monthly hour-long call
- Report back to chapter leadership regarding the content of the call

Time commitment: The Chapter Congress calls require one hour, monthly (typically 7pm on a Wednesday), plus a minimal amount of time in preparation beforehand and summarizing pertinent information for YNPn Board afterwards. This YNPn - Madison Board of Directors meets every three weeks. Board Members are also expected to regularly attend YNPn events.

- Opportunity to represent our chapter on a national level
- Opportunity to interact with our peers nationwide
- Development of communication skills
- Opportunity to consider our mission in a broader way
