## Early Voting Period

**October 17 - November 3**

# YOU MUST BE REGISTERED TO VOTE

## 3 Ways To Vote:



**Early Voting:** Vote at any early voting site in your county.

**Election Day:** You can only vote at your assigned polling place.

**By Mail:** Request an absentee ballot with this form: [youcanvote.org/mail](http://youcanvote.org/mail)

## Moving?

**Permanent move:** You must update your registration.

**Temporary move:** You can choose to register where you currently live, return home to vote OR request an absentee ballot.

## Who Can Register?

NC citizens who will be 18 by Election Day, 16 & 17 yr olds pre-register.

NC citizens who have completed the terms of their felony sentence.
