**Camp Moomba will be taking place from July 15 to 20 at YMCA Camp Elphinstone.** Camp Moomba was first held in 1998, and is open to youth who between 6 and 17 years old, and are living with HIV or have a close family member who is HIV-positive. ## Position Description

Group Leaders are the people that make camp happen! Group Leaders spend their time looking out for campers, and making sure everyone is having fun and ready to participate in camp activities. This role includes accompanying camper groups, sleeping in camper accommodations, and making sure campers' wellness is looked after.

Accommodation and food are provided during camp, and travel arrangements from the Lower Mainland in British Columbia will be arranged at no cost. Group Leaders who are travelling from cities where campers are also coming from are also welcome. *Please get in touch to find out if campers are travelling from your city.*

## Responsibilities

Group Leaders will be expected to:

- Actively participate in camp life and camp activities
- Attend to campers' wellbeing needs in ability-appropriate ways to ensure campers' physical, emotional, social, medical and nutritional needs are being met
- Support positive camper group dynamics to ensure a positive experience for all campers
- Manage camper behaviour, including role modelling camp appropriate behaviour and addressing concerns with the Camp Director
- Assist with camp-wide programming
- Provide leadership and role modeling to all staff and campers
- Attend and participate in Camp Moomba meetings as required

## Qualifications/Experience

- **Available for training and Camp Moomba from July 15 to 20**
- Must be at least 18 years of age and complete a criminal record check and vulnerable sector search
- Experience with YouthCO, Camp Moomba, and/or working with youth (6-17 years old)
- Passionate about building supportive communities for youth living with HIV
